**Directions to the Site:**

**From the North:** From I-5 take exit #127 (Hwy 512 Puyallup exit) toward Puyallup.

- Take the Pacific Ave. exit (Hwy 7) and turn right.
- Go South on Pacific Ave. approx. 5 miles to the Roy "Y" and bear right on WA-507/Spanaway McKenna Hwy.
- Go 1.2 miles and turn slight left onto 8th Ave. Continue another 5.2 miles.
- Just after crossing 288th St., turn left into the entrance to the Polo Field on a dirt road marked with signage. Follow dirt road to field.
- **From the South:** Take I-5 exit 88A (Tenino exit) and follow to Yelm.
- Turn right at the stop light and follow to McKenna.
- Turn right at the stop light in McKenna (Exxon) on Hwy 702/352nd St.
- Go 5.3 miles to the flashing yellow light and turn left on 8th Ave.
- Go approx. 3.5 miles. The Roy Polo Field is down a dirt road in the trees on the right, just before the 288th St. intersection, and will be marked with signage. Follow dirt road to field.

### ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY

Lure Coursing tests and trials shall be open to eligible breeds one year of age or older. Currently these include: Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengos (Medio and Grande), Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks, and Whippets. For a complete list of eligible breeds, visit the AKC website at: [http://www.akc.org/events/lure\\_coursing/eligible\\_breeds.cfm](http://www.akc.org/events/lure_coursing/eligible_breeds.cfm). Note: Italian Greyhounds and Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field. Eligible dogs must be either individually registered with AKC, recorded with FSS, individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, or that have been granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL/ILP). Hounds may not be entered as "registration pending" or "PAL/ILP pending" whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. A dog with an AKC Limited Registration shall be eligible to be entered in Lure Coursing tests and trials, as are spayed and neutered hounds. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate. FSS breeds may earn suffix titles only.

### RIBBONS

Evergreen Basenji Club will offer:

**JC/QC TESTS:** Qualifying Course = Green Ribbon

**TRIALS:** Rosettes: First = Blue, Second = Red, Third = Yellow,  
Fourth = White, Fifth = Pink, Best of Breed = Purple/Gold,  
Best in Field = Red, White, and Blue.

### TROPHIES

Trophies will be offered for **Best of Breed** and **Best in Field**.

### STAKES OFFERED

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST:** Open to all hounds of an eligible breed at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone shall receive one qualification from a judge, and a second qualification from a different Judge at a separate event, stating that the hound completed a six hundred (600) yard course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

**QUALIFIED COURSER TEST:** A hound at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed – or another breed with a similar running style – (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **This certification is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.** The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is strongly recommended that every Qualifying Hound have been run previously alone and that to the handler's satisfaction runs cleanly and keenly. It is additionally recommended that every Qualifying Hound practices with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test. It is to be understood by all that training prior to running a hound with other hounds in competition is essential to ensure that the hound is prepared to run safely with other hounds.

**OPEN:** Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser (QC) certificate. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title. **Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Championship title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake.**

**SPECIALS:** Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. Championship points earned from the Specials Stake will count toward Lure Courser Excellent (LCX) titles. Qualifying scores earned from the Specials Stake will count toward a Senior Courser (SC) or Master Courser (MC) title.

**VETERAN:** Open to all hounds which are eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and meet the age requirement for a veteran as established by the breed's parent club – 6 years of age; except Irish Wolfhounds = 5 years, and Whippets = 7 years. Championship points will be awarded. Points won from the Veteran Stake may count toward either a Field Championship (FC) title or Lure Courser Excellent (LCX) title.

**BEST IN FIELD:** All Best of Breed winners **with the exception of Italian Greyhounds and Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds** shall be eligible to compete for Best in Field.

## GENERAL

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the Test or Trial.
2. Stakes shall be split each time the entry is sufficient to hold two or more five point majors.
3. In the JC Test, all hounds will run alone. In the QC Test, each Qualifying Hound will run with one Testing Hound. In the Trial, all hounds will run twice, in trios if possible, or braces, unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
4. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five (5) minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications, bitches in season, and lame hounds, which will be excused and their entry fees refunded. Spayed or neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
5. Battery powered **continuous loop** machines will be used. Lure will consist of white plastic bags. Backup equipment will be available.
6. The course will be reversed for the finals and run-offs.
7. The field committee reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial.
8. **THE FIELD COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO BAR KNOWN AGGRESSIVE HOUNDS FROM THE TRIAL SITE.**
9. **THERE WILL BE A \$5.00 FINE ASSESSED FOR ANY LOOSE HOUND NOT TAKING PART IN THE COURSE IN PROGRESS, OR FOR ANYONE NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR OWN DOG(S). ALL TRASH, INCLUDING DOG FECES, MUST BE HAULED AWAY BY THE OWNER.**
10. **PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN SHADE, FOOD, AND WATER.**
11. **NO ONE, EXCEPT FIELD COMMITTEE, WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FIELD WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION OF THE FIELD CHAIRMAN.**
12. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
13. No cigarette smoking permitted on this field.

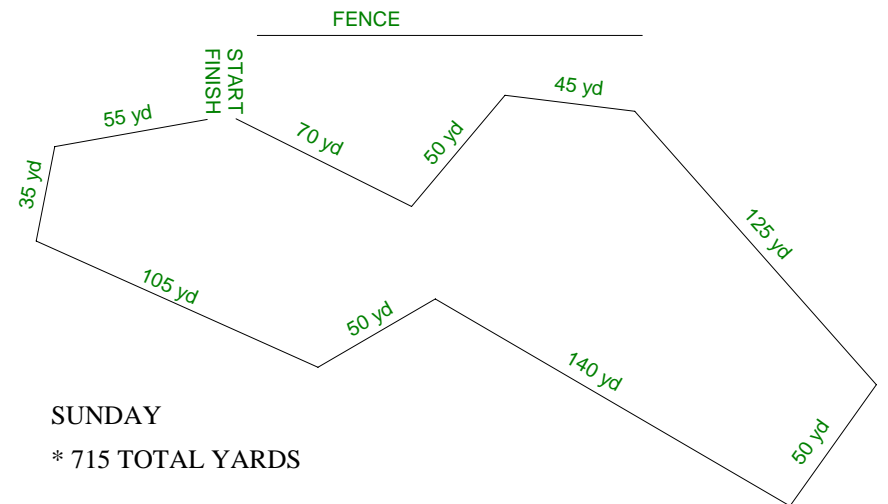
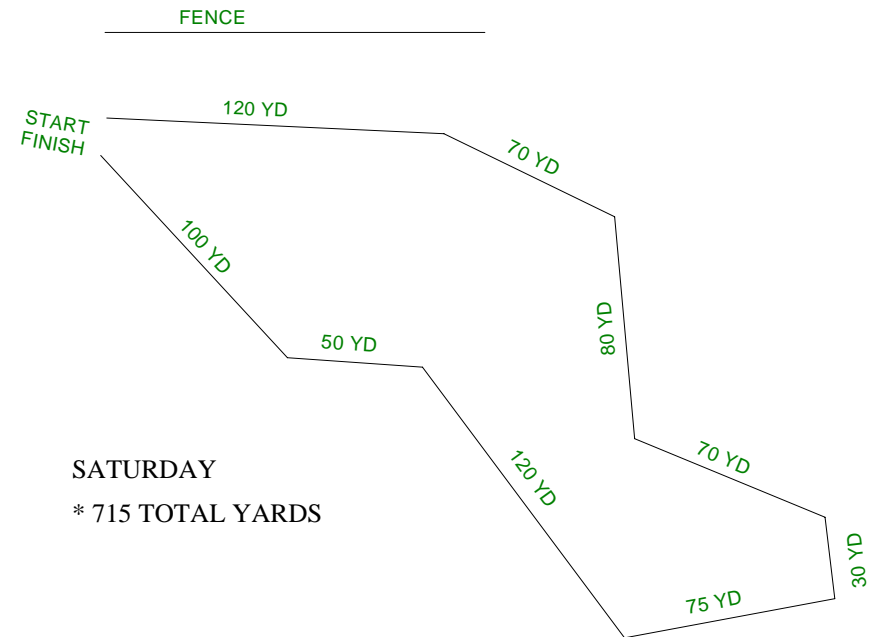
